ACTION ON MINUTES: No Action

Pastor Peter Smith addressed the committee on the **Future Outdoor Development for Hope Valley Community Church for 2009 and the Future Presentation to the Borough of Red Hill.**

Preliminary Plan:

- Establish a property Development Team to create a plan for the outside on the property.
- Potentially develop a Community Improvement District (CID). The Community Improvement District could be overseen by a Planning Team. The Planning Team could be made up of representatives from HVCC, the Red Hill Borough and from people living in the Borough of Red Hill. A goal of HVCC would be to develop the outside of the church property to meet as many needs of the community as possible. HVCC goal is to work together with the Borough of Red Hill to create a space as possible for the community.

Future Projects:

- Parking lot – A new parking lot around the church with extending the south parking lot.
- Walking Path – An exercise walking path around the church with connection the Red Hill Borough Park
- Outdoor Playground
- Outdoor Pavilion
- Outdoor Patio
- Indoor Playground & Café
- Purchasing the Sara Rutkowski Property – 1 1/4 acres
- Summer Film Festival

Hope Valley Community Church plans to develop a detailed proposal that could be presented to the borough, community organizations, businesses and philanthropic organizations. HVCC would like to present this detailed plan to the Red Hill Open Space Committee with the possibility of Red Hill securing funds from the county.

Doris Decker stated to Pastor Smith that the plan would be forwarded to Beth Pilling for her perusal and requesting comments on the plan.
