Revitalization Task Force

Doris Decker called the meeting of the Revitalization Meeting Task Force to order on the above date at 6:30 pm.

ACTION ON MINUTES: A motion to approve the Minutes of October 14, 2009 was made by Anthony D'Ippolito and seconded by Dennis Albertson. Motion carried unanimously.

Doris Decker asks the committee for the nomination of Dennis Albertson as vice chairperson.

Larry Morton nominated Dennis Albertson and Anthony D'Ippolito seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Doris Decker stated to the committee that Darlene Stoudt mailed the Borough of Red Hill Community Revitalization Task Force request for proposals to ten contractors on November 9th with a return date to Red Hill by no later than December 9th. Proposals after this date will NOT receive consideration. After the receipt of the proposals, the committee will interview the top 3 contractors.

Doris Decker also stated that she received an email from Brian O'Leary stating that the 2010 county budget does not have money for plan grant applications. Mr. O'Leary stated that he is going to continue to advocate money for these plans. Doris Decker stated if Red Hill would proceed without county money, once the plan is done, Red Hill is eligible for bricks and mortar implementation projects. If Red Hill secures a contract with community planning section, the community planner could do the revitalization plan for Red Hill.

Doris Decker stated to the committee that Joe Hoffman, BIA Grants Manager, was not present at the meeting to advise the committee on the grants that are available to Red Hill.

Doris Decker stated that she received several contractor requests on the proposal. Mark Hosterman stated the committee should review the proposals and to continue the process noting the requests as an exception on the proposals.

Project time Frame:

Doris Decker stated that the project and all of the results submitted to the Red Hill Borough's Community Revitalization Task Force must be within nine months from the date of the execution of the contract with the consultant.

Doris Decker proposed implementing the project for the business district within the area of 4th to 6th on Main Street and branch out one block in each direction at a time.

Doris Decker stated the next meeting is scheduled for December 10th, 2009.

Tim Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Larry Morton seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 8:00pm.
