**SANITATION AND RECYCLING: Faith Diascro**

- Stealing bags from the trash container
- Citizens' not purchasing new trash bags, because the trash collector is not taking the bags off of the containers.
- Trash bags are blown away when the trash container lid is not utilized.

**GREEN STAR RECYCLING**

**REVITALIZATION - Doris Decker**
