

Stormwater Did You Know?

Due to hard surfaces like pavement and rooftops, a typical City block generates **5x's more stormwater runoff** than a woodland area of the same size

We can't always stop pollution, but we can offset it

The NPDES permit looks for water pollution controls to treat stormwater before it gets discharged into surface waters

Stormwater is powerful

1 inch of rain on 1 acre of land is equivalent to 27,154 gallons of water, weighing about 113 tons

NPDES permit looks to minimize soil erosion
