What is a Rain Garden?

A rain garden is a bowl shaped garden designed to collect several inches of water during a storm, providing time for infiltration into the ground and absorption by native plants – 2 natural ways of filtering out pollutants!

Rain Garden Benefits

- Reduces stormwater runoff and flooding.
- Filters pollutants.
- Rechargers groundwater resources.
- Low maintenance landscaping!
- Attracts birds, butterflies and other wildlife.
- Increases beneficial insects.
- Decreases mosquitos
