

## Preventing the Spread of the Spotted Lanternfly

The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture and Penn State Extension have provided a fact sheet with recommendations on how to kill or control adult spotted lanternflies. The fact sheet includes a list of consumer insecticide products containing the most effective ingredients against this invasive species that have been studied to date (dinotefuran, imidacloprid, carbaryl, and bifenthrin).
